

Ethiopia and South Africa signed an agreement to extradite individuals suspected of crimes

The fourth meeting of the Ethio-South Africa Joint Ministerial Commission was held in Addis Ababa. Deputy Prime Minister and Minister of Foreign Affairs Demeke Mekonen, South Africa's Minister of International Relations and Cooperation Dr. Naledi Pandor and officials of the two countries participated in the meeting.
